

Make an adorable domed box using your Envelope Punch Board. Fill it with fancy chocolates or candy. Perfect for a hostess or at a table setting. Minimal supplies required and you can make it in minutes.



## **Supplies List:**

- **Stamps**: Watercolor Wings (photopolymer 139424); Garden in Bloom (photopolymer 139433)
- Ink: Tip Taupe Taupe(138325) and Soft Sky(131181) Classic Stampin' Pads; Stazon Jet Black Pad(101406); Stampin' Write Markers: Sahara Sand from Neutrals Collection (131261), Lost Lagoon from In Color 2014-2016 Collection (133654), and Delightful Dijon from In Color 2015-2017 Collection (138333)
- Paper: English Garden Designer Series Paper (138440): 6 x 6"; Whisper White cardstocl (100730): 2 ½ x 2"
- Accessories: Envelope Punch Board (133774); Note Tag Punch (135860); 1/8" Circle Handheld Punch (134363); Baker's Twine White (124262); 1" Dotted Lace Trim Mint Macaron (128424); Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995)

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Line up Designer Series Paper (DSP) at 1.5" on the punch board and punch, and then score in the right hand groove only.
- 2. Turn paper 90 degrees and line up the edge at 3" on the punch board and punch, and then score in the right hand groove only.
- 3. Turn paper 90 degrees and line up the edge at 1.5" on the punch board and punch, and then score in the right hand groove only.
- 4. Turn paper 90 degrees and line up the edge at 3" on the punch board and punch, and then score in the right hand groove only.
- 5. Flip the DSP over and line up the DSP at 1.5" and punch only.
- 6. Turn the DSP 90 degrees and line up the DSP at 3" and punch only.
- 7. Repeat steps 5 and 6.
- 8. Round all the corners in the corner round punch on the punch board.
- 9. Cut into each of the corners at the end of the long box shape (see Picture 1)
- 10. Add the Tear and Tape Adhesive to each of the flaps you just created and then fold in to close up the bottom part of the box (see Picture 2).
- 11. Gently fold in the rest of the flaps to keep the dome shape.
- 12. Secure the box closed by tying the lace ribbon around and tying it in a knot and then a bow.
- 13. Punch out a tag shape from the white cardstock.
- 14. Stamp the saying with Mint Macaron ink and the butterfly with Blushing Bride ink.
- 15. Punch a hole in the tag.
- 16. Thread the Bakers Twine through the hole and attach the tag to the lace trim.
