Supplies List:

- **Stamps**: Cheer All Year Stamp Set (photopolymer 139839)
- Ink: Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad (140931); Tangelo Twist Classic Stampin' Pad (133646)
- **Paper**: Basic Black Cardstock (121045): 2" x 11", scored at 4 1/4"; Happy Hauntings Designer Series Paper (139584): 1 7/8" x 4 1/8"; Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650): scrap
- Accessories: Spider Web Doilies (139622); Very Vanilla Thick Baker's Twine (138411); 3/4" Circle Punch (119873); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Fine-Tip Glue Pen (138309); Bone Folder (102300)

Instructions:

- 1. Fold the Basic Black Cardstock on score line and crease with Bone Folder.
- 2. Place 1" strips of Tear & Tape on the back of the front panel at the top. Adhere to back panel to create your pocket.
- 3. Adhere Designer Series Paper to the front pocket panel using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 4. Adhere Spider Web Doily to the front using Fine-Tip Glue Pen. Trim off excess. TIP: Apply glue in dots, not lines.
- 5. Stamp bat in Basic Black and 'boo' in Tangelo Twist on a scrap of Very Vanilla.
- 6. Cut out bat and punch out 'boo'.
- 7. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on back of bat and 'boo'.
- 8. Cut a length of Very Vanilla Thick Baker's Twine. Unravel threads.
- 9. Wrap threads around fingers loosely and place onto the adhesive on the back of the bat. Adhere to treat pocket.
- 10. Adhere 'boo' to bat.
