

For the sweet 16 or change for any age! Pull your colors from the Designer Paper and it's a cinch!



Supplies List:

- Paper: Basic Black 12x12 cardstock (124267); Mint Macaron cardstock (138337): 5-3/4" x 2-1/2" plus scraps for die cutting; Hello Honey cardstock (133678): scraps for die-cutting (a half sheet should do it); Old Olive cardstock (100702): scraps for die-cutting; Cajun Craze cardstock (119684): scraps for die-cutting; Botanical Gardens Designer Series Paper: 11-1/2" x 11-1/2"; 4" x 6"; 4" x 3" (X4)
- Accessories: Big Shot Die-cutting Machine (113439); Botanical Building Framelits Dies (140625); Large Numbers Framelits Dies (140622); Hello You Thinlits (137363); Botanical Gardens Jewels (140585); Rhinestone Basic Jewels (119246); Fast Fuse Adhesive (129026); Fine-Tip Glue Pen (139309); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere Designer Series Paper (DSP) to 12x12 cardstock.
- 2. Die cut "happy", "1", and "6" from Hello Honey cardstock and adhere to Mint Macaron cardstock with Fine-Tip Glue Pen.
- 3. Die cut as many flowers and leaves as you would like. For this sample, I cut 1 large Hello Honey; one each medium flower, small flower, and stamens from Hello Honey, Cajun Craze, and Mint Macaron; and 5 fern-shaped leaves from Old Olive.
- 4. Mount photos to DSP mats and adhere to page. (Use one or more photo blocks for journaling if you want). Adhere title block.
- 5. Adhere flowers using Fine-Tip Glue Pen and/or Mini Glue Dots where desired. Embellish with a Botanical Gardens Jewel (using a glue dot) and Rhinestone Basic Jewels.
