


Time to plan those summer pages. Create this sweet page complete with a cool creamy ice cream cone compliments of the Sprinkles of Life Stamp Set and coordinating Tree Builder Punch.



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Supplies List:

- Stamps: Sprinkles of Life (photopolymer: 139971)
- Ink: Tip Top Taupe Classic Stampin' Pad (138325)
- Paper: Hello Honey cardstock (133678), Pool Party cardstock (122924), Soft Suede cardstock (115318): 12" x 12", Very Vanilla cardstock (101650): 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" (2) and 3" X 4-1/2", and Watermelon Wonder cardstock (138334): 4-3/4"x 6-3/4" (2) and 3-1/4" x 4-3/4"; Sweet Li'l Things Designer Series Paper (138447): 2" x 12" and 4" x 12"
- Accessories: Big Shot die-cutting machine (113439); Little Letters Thinlits (133730); 12" x 12" Page Protectors (135296); Tree Builder Punch (138295); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere 2" x 12" and 4" x 12" pieces of Sweet Li'l Things Designer Series paper on left side of Soft Suede 12" x 12" with Multipurpose Liquid Glue as shown.
- 2. Adhere Very Vanilla cardstock to corresponding Watermelon Wonder cardstock with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 3. Die cut the word "Sweet" from Hello Honey and Pool Party scraps. Adhere directly under the journaling block with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Skew the letters a bit when adhering.
- 4. Stamp Ice Cream Cone from stamp set on Very Vanilla cardstock with Tip Top Taupe ink. Fussy cut and adhere to page as shown in photo.
- 5. Using the Tree Builder Punch, punch the "cloud" image (or scoops) four times from different patterns from Sweet Li'l things designer series paper. Stack and glue the scoops with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 6. Using the Tree Builder Punch, punch the cherry image from Watermelon Wonder scrap. Adhere to top scoop of ice cream cone with a small dot of Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 7. Protect your page with a 12" x 12" page protector.
