

The most important parts of a scrapbook page are the journaling and the photos, in that order. So I like to keep my scrapbook pages simple.



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Supplies List:

- Paper: Basic Black 12x12 cardstock (124267); Basic Black cardstock (121045): 6-1/4" x 4-1/4", 5-1/2" x 3-1/2", 5-1/2" x 2", 1" x 9"; Real Red cardstock (102482): 1-1/2" x 9-3/8", 1-1/2" x 11" for die-cutting; Whisper White cardstock (100730): 5-1/4" x 1-3/4" for journaling; Home for Christmas Designer Series Paper (139592): Pool Party dotted: 11-1/2" x 11-1/2"), Holly print: 2" x 9-3/4", Santa sheet to cut out Santas
- Accessories: Big Shot die-cutting machine (113439); Little Letters Thinlits (133730); Banner Triple Punch (138292); Paper Snips (103579); Fast Fuse Adhesive (129026); Fine-Tip Glue Pen (138309); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere Pool Party dotted paper to 12x12 Basic Black cardstock for page base.
- 2. Use Banner Triple punch to punch ends of holly print, Real Red cardstock strip, and Basic Black cardstock strip. Adhere 3 layers together, aligning at straight end. Adhere 3/4" from bottom of scrapbook page base.
- 3. Die cut letters, HOHOHOLIDAYS, from Real Red cardstock. Glue with Fine-Tip Glue Pen about 1" from top of scrapbook page base. Tip: use temporary adhesive to adhere a strip of paper or cardstock to page to act as a guide for straight placement, or place letters in a random way.
- 4. Use Basic Black cardstock shapes to mat photographs, modifying dimensions as needed. Adhere to page. Layer journaling piece to black mat and adhere to page.
- 5. "Fussy" cut several Santa shapes from Designer Series Paper and attach with Stampin' Dimensionals.
