


I was recently challenged to design a scrapbook page that could be completed in under 15 minutes! That was a hard challenge for me! I've been known to spend a whole afternoon designing a single page!!! Yet I was really pleased with how the page turned out. If you've ever had the chance to travel to New York City, then you're going to love this quick and easy layout featuring Soho Subway Designer Series Paper for your vacation photos!



## SUPPLIES LIST:

PAPER: Soho Subway Designer Series Paper (130140), Early Espresso 12x12 Cardstock (124276), Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650)

ACCESSORIES: Stampin' Trimmer (126889), Snail Adhesive (104332)

## Instructions:

- 1. In your package of Soho Subway DSP you have two sheets that are Very Vanilla with an Island Indigo grid on one side and a collage of NYC locations on the reverse. I used the grid side of one sheet for the background and the collage side of the other for the focal pieces.
- 2. Choose the DSP strips containing the locations that you want to feature and use your Stampin' Trimmer to cut the sections apart.
- 3. Adhere a 12" x 2" piece of Early Espresso CS across the top with Snail adhesive. Adhere the 12" x 1.75" wide strip of DSP that features "New York / New York" to the Early Espresso CS.
- 4. Adhere an 8.25" x 2.75" strip of Early Espresso CS to cover the numbers on the background DSP. Adhere the 7.75" x 2.5" strip of DSP that features "Times Square / Central Park / Radio City Music Hall" to the Early Espresso CS.
- 5. Adhere a 6.5" x 4.5" piece of Early Espresso CS to use as the mat for a 4" x 6" photo.
- Adhere a 4.5" square piece of Early Espresso CS to use as the mat for a photo that has been cropped to a 4" square.
  NOTE: (In the photo of the project I have a 4" x 6" piece & a 4" square piece of Very Vanilla CS to show where you will place your photos.)
- 7. Adhere a 4" x 3" piece of Soho Subway DSP in the bottom right-hand corner. I chose the DSP that has the Island Indigo background with Very Vanilla grid. Adhere a 3.5" x 2.5" piece of Very Vanilla CS to use for journaling, or you may choose to crop a photo to feature here.
- 8. Add this page to your scrapbook or place in a 12" x 12" frame to hang on your wall.
