



The new Baker's Box die is adorable and perfect to use for a little gift of treats for your family, friends or co-workers. Makes someone's day with this little treat box. Love isn't just for Valentines!



Supplies List:

- **Stamps:** A Nice Cuppa (photopolymer 140683); Happy Home (wood – 140500; clear 140503)
- **Ink:** Smoky Slate (131179); Whisper White (101731); Real Red (126949) Classic Stampin' Pads
- **Paper:** Smoky Slate (131202): 6" x 7" (2 pieces) or if you are careful, you can use one piece of 11 x 7 (to cut into two die cut pieces); Whisper White Cardstock (100730): 2" x 1 ½"
- **Accessories:** Bakers Box Thinlets Dies (138279); 5/8" Organza Ribbon (114319); Whisper White Bakers Twine (124262); 1/16" Handheld Circle Punch (134363); Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995)

Instructions:

1. Cut out the box from the Smoky Slate cardstock and the die on the Big Shot. You will need to cut out two pieces of the box shape. Then cut the box top holes using the die from the set. You can cut these at the same time as the box shape or after.
2. On the box cut outs, stamp the hearts from the "A Nice Cuppa" stamp set, using Smoky Slate, Real Red and Whisper White ink. Be sure to put the project aside for a few minutes to let the Whisper White ink dry.
3. Fold in the boxes on all the scoring lines.
4. To form the box, work with the sides flat. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive along the long thin flaps of the two box pieces. Attach one cut out to the other along this flap. Then form the box shape by attaching the final flap to the other side of the box (see picture 2).
5. Fold the bottom of the box closed as shown in the instructions (see picture 3).
6. Stamp the tag with the saying from "Happy Home" with Real Red ink.
7. Poke a small hole in the top of the tag and thread 6" of White Baker's twine through the tag and tie it through the holes at the top of the box. TIP: If you tie the thread to just ONE side of the holes, the tag will stay in place when the box is opened.
8. Fill the box with treats.
9. Tie a 7" piece of White Organza ribbon through BOTH sides of the box top and tie it closed.
