



From the time I first saw the Botanical Gardens Designer Series Paper, I thought that several of the sheets would make fun Hawaiian “Aloha” Shirts. These are great cards for masculine birthdays, and even for Father’s Day.



Supplies List:

- **Stamps:** Sassy Salutations (wood – 132070, clear – 126707)
- **Ink:** Cajun Craze (126965) Classic Stampin' Pad
- **Paper:** Botanical Gardens Designer Series Paper (140583), 6” square; Whisper White Cardstock (100730), 4-1/2” x 7”; 1-1/8” x 3-1/2”; Cajun Craze Cardstock (119684), 1-1/4” x 3-3/4”; scrap for punching (optional)
- **Accessories:** Stampin’ Trimmer (126889); Paper Snips (103579); Mini Glue Dots (103683); SNAIL Adhesive (104332); (Optional) Owl Builder Punch (118074); Envelope Punch Board (133774); Plain copy paper, 8-1/2” x 11”

Instructions:

Scoring and cutting Designer Series Paper (DSP) (Image 1)

1. Score the Designer Series Paper (DSP) left to right at 3/4” and 1-1/2” from the top edge, and top to bottom 1 1/4” from the right and left edges.
2. Cut along the vertical score lines from the top edge to the 1-1/2” score lines.
3. Cut along the 1-1/2” score line 2” from both the left and the right edges.

Making the collar (Image 2)

4. Fold the top edge to the back on the 3/4" score line.
5. Fold the right and left sides of the top folded edge at an angle in towards the center of the 1-1/2" score line with the top corners meeting in the middle. Adhere the tips of the collar to the shirt base using Mini Glue Dots.

Making the sleeves (Image 3)

6. Make a mark at the left and right edges up 2" from the bottom edge.
7. Fold the left and right edges to the back on the 1-1/4" score lines.
8. Turn the paper over and score both sides from the 2" mark to the top of the folds.
9. Fold on the score line so that the top corners of both sides show on the front to make the sleeves.
10. Adhere the folded sides to the back of the shirt, and tack the sleeves to the shirt back near the middle of the fold, making sure that none of the adhesive shows on the front.

Forming the Card (Image 3)

11. Fold the large piece of Whisper White Cardstock to make a 4-1/2" high x 3-1/2" wide card, folded on the side.
12. Adhere the card to the back of the shirt so that the bottom and left and right edges of the card are aligned.

Decorating the Card (Finished Image)

13. Stamp Happy Birthday on the smaller piece of Whisper White Cardstock using Cajun Craze Classic Ink.
14. Use Paper Snips to cut notches in both ends of the cardstock.
15. Adhere this to the larger piece of Cajun Craze Cardstock and cut notches to match those on the stamped piece.
16. (Optional) To make button for the card front, punch 4 circles using the smaller two circles in the Owl Builder Punch. Adhere the buttons to the front of the card as shown, using Mini Glue Dots.

Making an Envelope for the Card.

17. This card is a bit too large to fit in a Stampin' Up! Medium (A2) Envelope. Use the Envelope Punch Board to make a card 5" x 5-1/2". This calls for 8-1/2" square paper, which you can cut from plain copy paper. Be sure before the final steps to adhere the card together that the width is 5-1/2" and the height is 5". This allows the use of a standard First-Class stamp in the United States.


