



When you're looking for a new technique to create a special birthday card, grab some washi tape and turn it into a party hat! This technique is very easy to do and works for young, old, or any age in between.



Supplies List:

- **Stamps:** Amazing Birthday (wood - 134225, clear - 134228)
- **Ink:** Bermuda Bay Classic Ink Pad (131171)
- **Paper:** Cucumber Crush Cardstock (138324): 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; Soft Sky Cardstock (131203): 5 7/8" x 3 1/8"; Whisper White Cardstock (100730): 3" x 4"
- **Accessories:** Cherry on Top Designer Washi Tape (138384); Crushed Curry Bakers Twine (134586); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL Adhesive (104332); Bone Folder (102300)

Instructions:

1. Fold the Cucumber Crush Cardstock in half and crease well with a Bone Folder to make your card base.
2. Using your SNAIL, adhere the piece of Soft Sky Cardstock to the card base,
3. Stamp your sentiment with Bermuda Bay ink onto the top right-hand corner of the Soft Sky Cardstock.
4. Create hat base by placing 3" x 4" white cardstock into trimmer with 3" side at the top. Put left-hand edge of paper at 1-1/2" and cut diagonally down to left corner. Repeat on right side.
5. Alternate strips of washi tape at an angle onto hat base, starting at bottom left-hand corner.
6. Attach 4" of baker's twine to bottom of hat to create 'strap' for hat.
7. Create pom pom by wrapping at least 36" of baker's twine around 2 fingers several times. Slip off fingers; tie string around middle and knot. Snip loops at both ends and fluff up.
8. Attach hat to card front using dimensionals.
9. Attach pom pom to top of hat using mini glue dots.
